

Technology

All Year 8 students will complete a semester rotation of Industrial Technology and Design and Home Economics. Students will develop the foundation skills required to then further engage within the subjects offered in the Technology faculty in years 9-12. Students will work through a range of practical situations to produce quality products. In Years 9 and 10, students have the opportunity to further develop their prior knowledge and foundation skills in preparation for selection of senior subjects.

The Technology faculty offers a broad range of subjects in Years 11 and 12 to cater for a variety of career paths. These include authority subjects; Graphics and Home Economics and Vocational Education and Training (VET) certificates; Certificate 1 in Furnishings, Certificate 1 in Engineering, Certificate 2 in Horticulture, Certificate 1 in Hospitality and Certificate 3 in Children's Services. In addition to these subjects, a Study Area Specification (SAS) subject is offered; Industrial Technology Studies. These subjects allow students to develop a range of specialist practical skills and knowledge within a specific industry field.

All Technology subjects have a practical and theoretical element to the student's learning. Assessment is varied including; written exams, essays and reports, design process based journals and the development of practical products and skills.

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
